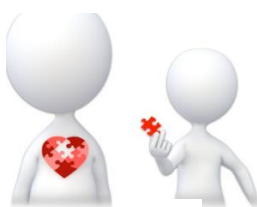
Personal Ministries Dept: "Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy..." **Revelation 1:3**
